4.	Policy update
	• EP FTA -affected by COVID-19. However, submissions for GI's due 27 March 2020.
	 Copyright Act review still under way with options paper hopefully prior to September's election.
5.	Update on cancellation of International Registrations and transformation requests
	 IPONZ is actioning this immediately and is looking creating a status for this but may take time to create as requires a system update.
	• IPONZ will not change lowering the 12 month time for a response deadline just yet, but is considering lowering it to six months, but is going to monitor before deciding.
6.	Proposals to discuss for regulatory reform
	 Proposing to have regulation to stipulate providing application number for convention application within set time frame.
	 Proposing to remove the requirement to provide schedule reference for Nice Classification.
7.	Other Business
	 Hearings: The scheduling of hearings should now advance more quickly now that Hearings Officers have been recently appointed.
	• Guidelines on length of submissions is to be released.
	• Guidelines on volume of evidence is to be released.
	• Guidelines on video conferencing is to be released.
	 Case management system to be updated, such as scheduling of hearing dates and uploading of electronic papers for the Hearing as opposed printing off papers.
